GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The Scholarship will cover 50% of tuition fees and does not include sundries, music tuition, subject or course levies, textbooks or school laptop program.
2. The Year 7 Scholarship is for four (4) years and is inclusive of Year 7, 8, 9 and 10.
3. Uniform costs are excluded from the Scholarship.
4. Selection will take place by date of application and the final decision will be given by the College Board.
5. The decision given by the College Board is final and no further discussion will be entered into.
6. The Principal will inform the family of the Board's decision and invite the family to an enrolment interview.
7. A Scholarship will be awarded based on a combination of the following criteria:
 - i. The application content.
 - ii. Exemplary general conduct record, if available.
 - iii. The Scholarship may be withdrawn at any time in the event of poor conduct or poor performance in terms of the nature of the Scholarship, following which the parent(s)/guardian(s) will be responsible for the full payment of ongoing fees.
8. Applicants are required to be a citizen or permanent resident of Australia and residing in Western Australia.
