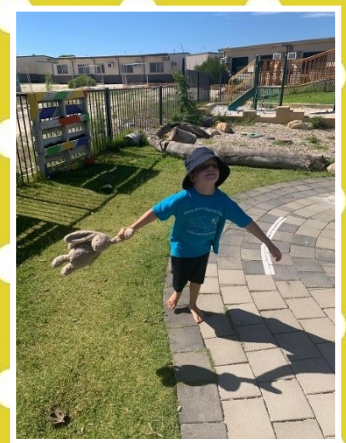


KINDY IS THE BEARY BEST!

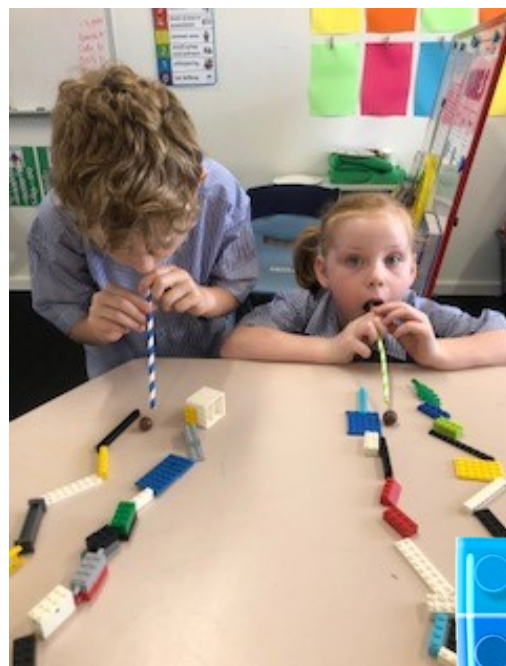
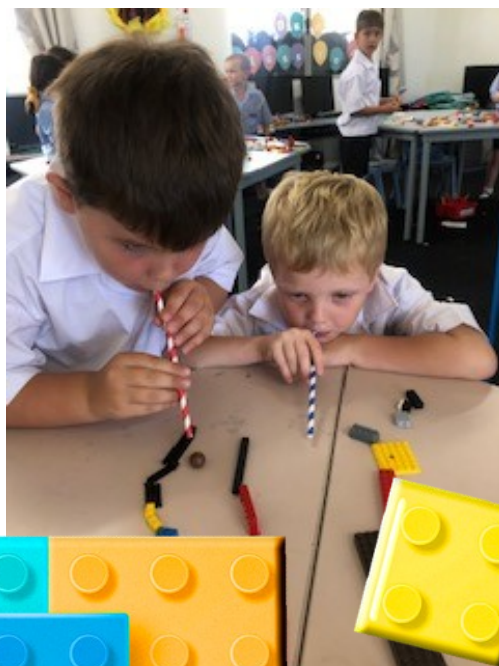

LEARNING ABOUT HISTORY AND CULTURE

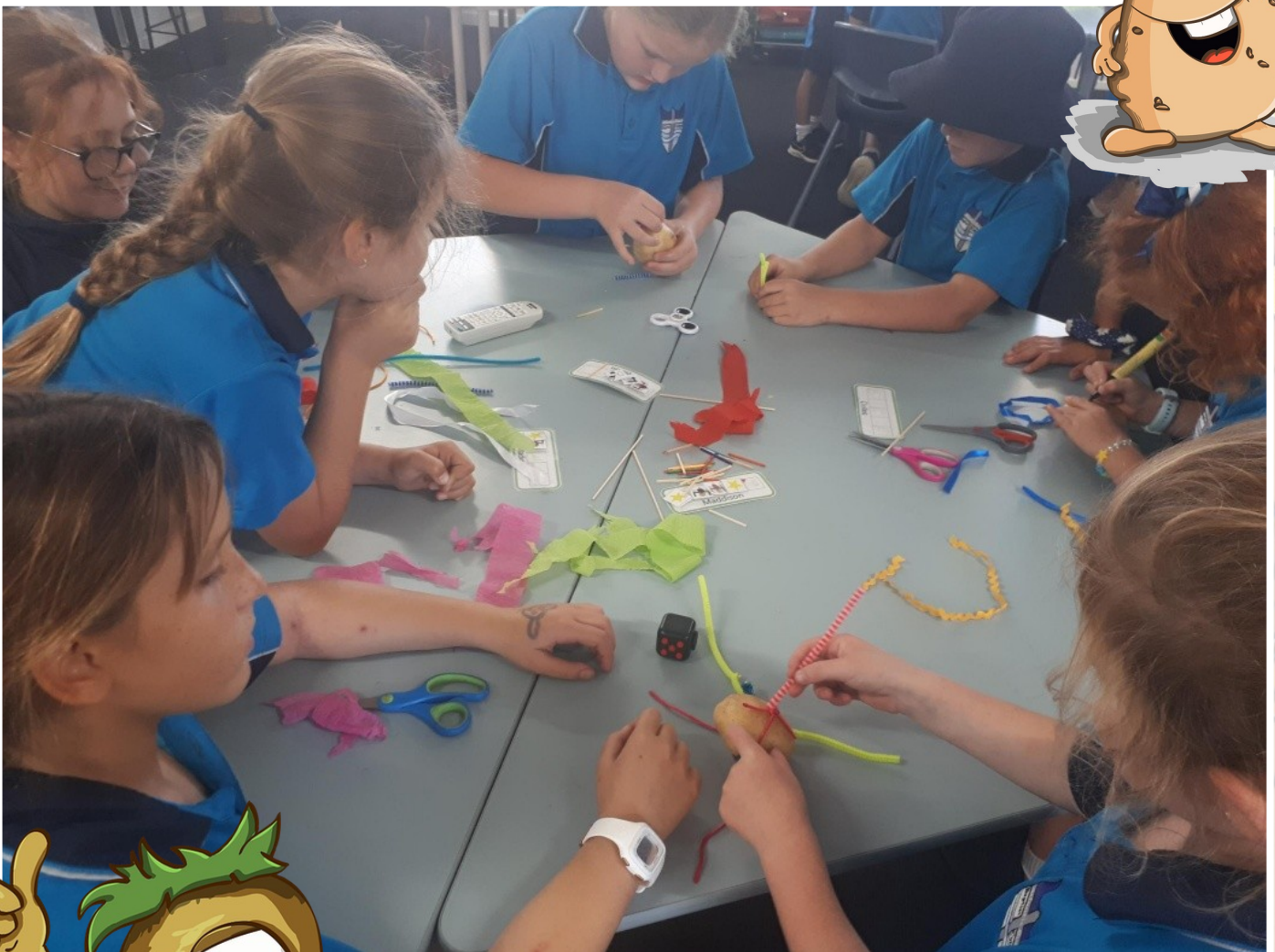
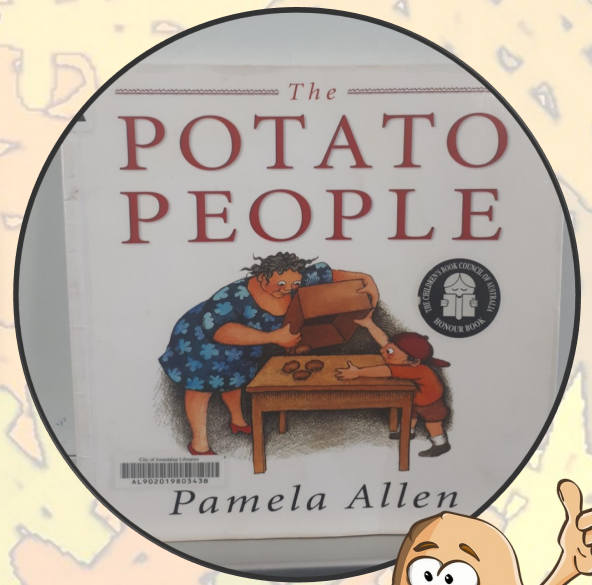

Gifted author, Helen Smith, is connected to one of our college families. The Otway family generously donated some of Helen's books to our growing 'library'. We are grateful. Thank you!





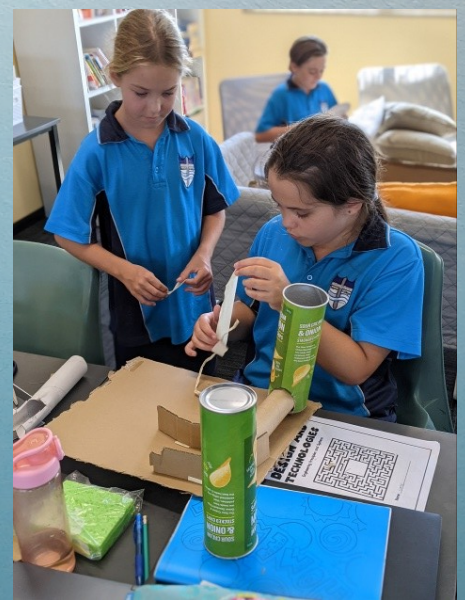
LEARNING ISN'T A CHORE

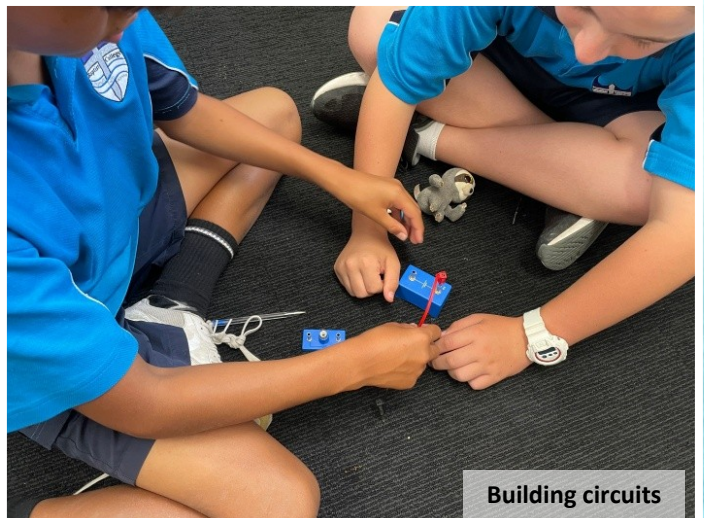

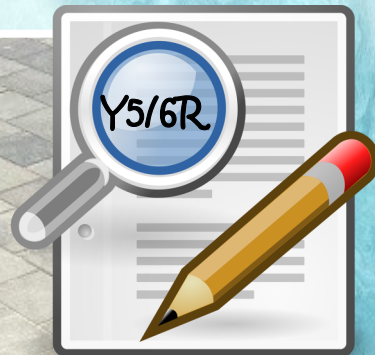

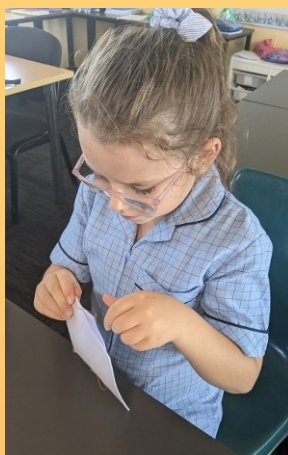

Easter Bonnets / Hats are to be made at home and brought in on the last day of term!

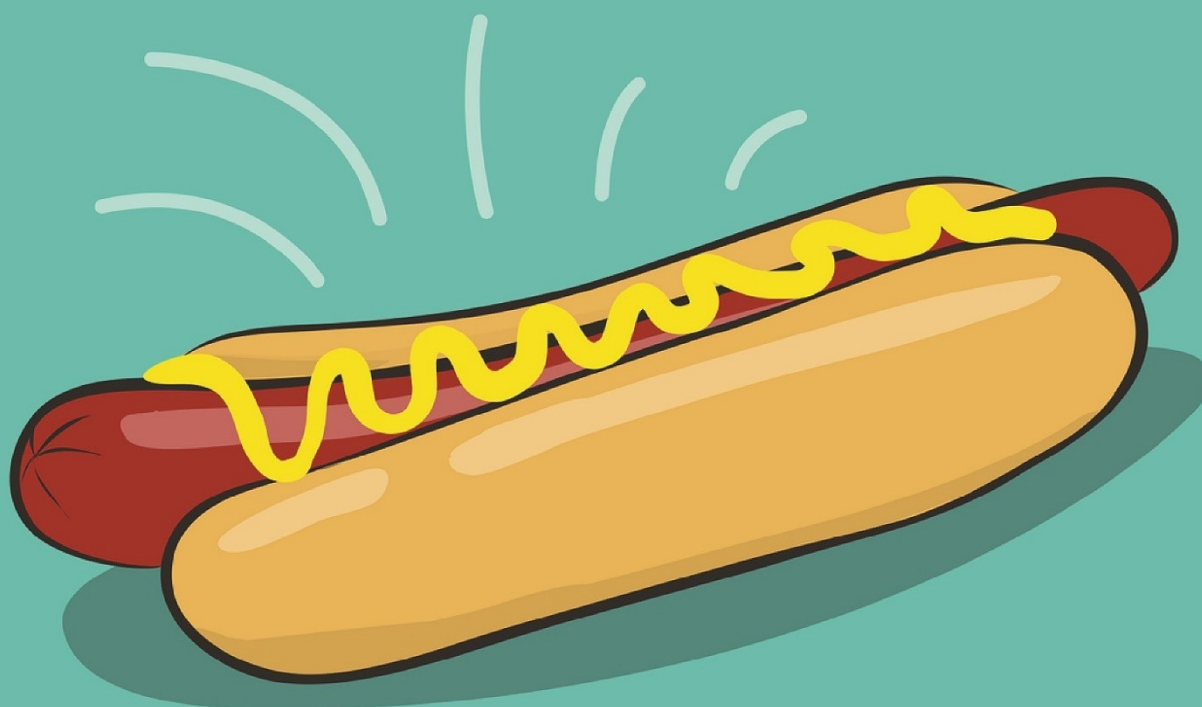
Prizes for the best bonnet or hat creation from each class and one for the best teacher.
